Handicap Structure 90% of 220 for Singles and All-Events & 90% of 440 for Doubles

Senior National Championship for 2026: In order to be eligible for this entry, you must bowl in doubles & singles and pay the \$5.00 optional All-Events fee.

Make Checks payable to: **DSUSBCA**. There will be a \$45 charge for (nfs) checks. Any checks returned for nfs will not be accepted from that individual or organization again. Only a money order, bill pay, or cash will be accepted. **(ALL ENTRIES ARE NON-REFUNDABLE)**

SENIOR TOURNAMENT RULES

1. This tournament observes the rules of USBC and is certified by USBC.
2. **ELIGIBILITY:** Bowler must be 50 years of age or over, as of November 15, 2025, and a current USBC member. **The entrant MUST be sanctioned with a minimum of 21 games in any USBC league prior to the tournament. Out-of-state memberships are permitted.**
3. **EVENTS:**
 - a) This tournament will consist of doubles, singles and optional all-events.
 - b) Doubles will be one division only. Any two (2) bowlers aged fifty or older may team up (2 men / 2 women / 1 man & 1 woman). You do **NOT** have to be in the same age group.
 - c) **Bowlers may enter events multiple times. He/she may enter with same partner only once , any other entries in doubles must be with a different partner, meaning you may bowl with the same partner only one time.**
 - d) In order to be eligible for All-Events, the bowler must bowl in both doubles and singles.
 - e) In order to be eligible for the National Seniors Entry, the bowler must bowl in both doubles and singles, and must pay the optional All-Events fee.
4. The paid all-events winner in each age division will be eligible to enter the USBC Senior Championship. **If a bowler bowls singles/doubles multiple times and has paid the optional all-events fee, the first score bowled in each event will be the score used to determine the qualifying national all-events score.** If the winner elects not to attend, it will go to the next highest all-events score in that age class, continue for up to the third positions, at that point no bowler will be sent.
5. Cash prizes will be awarded to the winners on a handicap basis for each division. Prize fees will be returned 100%. Unused expense money will be added to the prize fund. The prize ratio for doubles and singles will be at least 1 in 5 and the all-events ratio will be at least 1 in 10. A bowler is eligible to cash more than once if he/she has bowled multiple times.
6. **OFFICIAL TOURNAMENT AVERAGE:** Handicap shall be based on the highest 23/24 **USBC Final Certified League Average.** **Winter and Summer averages will be used.** Averages will be verified by use of the official association average books and USBC Website. If an entrant does not have a USBC average for 24/25, they will use the current 25-26 season's twenty-one game sanctioned league average as of 11/8/2025. **This league average must be from a Certified League and the bowler must supply an average sheet or league secretary verification.** If you do not fall into these two options, you will bowl scratch with a 220 average. It is the bowler's responsibility to supply a verified certified league average sheet if no book average. Averages will be verified and corrected, as necessary. Handicap structure: 90% of 220 for Singles and All-Events; 90% of 440 for Doubles.
7. USBC Rule 319a, item 2 (10 or more pin increase in average), 319c, 319d, and 319e **WILL NOT APPLY** in this tournament.
8. Report all substitutions to the Tournament Office **at least 30 minutes prior** to bowling.
9. In the event of ties, co-champions will be declared, and the prize money will be combined and split evenly between the tied positions. Prize money payout will be: 1 division for doubles, regardless of age, 6 divisions for singles and paid all-events; these divisions are 75+, 70-74, 65-69, 60-64, 55-59, and 50-54.
10. In the event of a tie for Nation All-Events, **the high series with handicap in the singles event will determine the National All Events Champion** that will go to the National Senior's Championship.
11. The DSUSBC will only be sending a maximum of 6 winners (men & women combined) to the national tournament.
12. Please arrive ready to bowl **at least 30 minutes prior** to squad time. Please check-in upon arrival.
